(Please include your company name, address, telephone and fax as well as contact person). **No electronic bids will be accepted.**

The City of Weslaco reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids to waive any formalities in the bidding or to accept the bid to be the best and most advantageous to the City and to hold bids for a period of forty-five (45) days from the date of the bid opening without taking action for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigation of bidders' qualifications prior to bid purchase award. Bids submitted past the aforementioned date and time will not be accepted.

**CITY OF WESLACO
SOLICITATION FOR BID**

AUTOMOTIVE FUEL

IT IS THE INTENT OF THESE SPECIFICATIONS TO DESCRIBE AND GOVERN THE PURCHASE PRICE OF REGULAR UNLEADED AND LOW SULFUR DIESEL FUEL FOR USE BY ALL DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF WESLACO.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope upon the blank form attached hereto. Each form must be completely filled out. Bids must be filed with the City of Weslaco before opening day and hour. No late bids will be accepted. They will be returned to respondent unopened (if properly identified). Failure to meet request for Bid (s) requirements may be grounds for disqualification.
2. Bids MUST give full firm name and address of respondent, and be manually signed. Failure to do so will disqualify your Bid. Person signing Bid must show title or AUTHORITY TO BIND HIS/HER FIRM IN A CONTRACT. Firm name and authorized signature must appear on each page that calls for this information.
3. Bids CANNOT be altered or amended after opening time. Alterations made before opening time must be initialed by respondent guaranteeing authenticity. No Bid may be withdrawn after opening time without acceptable reason in writing and only after approval by the City of Weslaco.
4. Vendor will bid on 5,000 gallon loads for both Eighty Seven (87) Octane Unleaded and Low Sulfur Diesel Fuels.
5. The period of this contract shall be from notification of award date and terminate exactly one year after.
6. Bid shall be a set amount or percent over the Oil Price Information Service (OPIS also referred to as the RACK Price) for the Lower Rio Grande Valley or Harlingen Area. The City of Weslaco recognizes floating nature of fuel prices but seeks to insure a set price above this price. It shall be the vendor's responsibility to include a copy of the OPIS price sheet with every load of fuel delivered and invoiced, with the same date fuel was ordered.
7. Freight Cost as indicated in the Base Bid Price shall remain firm for the term of contract.
8. It is anticipated that the City will have a need for approximately 150,000 gallons of regular unleaded gasoline and 100,000 gallons of low sulfur diesel fuel throughout the one year term of this contract. This is not to be construed as a guaranteed quantity of purchase from the City of Weslaco.
9. All fuel deliveries shall be made to a central location as may be designated by the City of Weslaco. The City reserves the right to change or add delivery locations.
10. In order for the City to meet its needs, it is understood that during the period of the contract, should successful bidder be unable to supply product, the City reserves the right to obtain product from available sources.

11. It shall be the legal obligation of the vendor during the term of the contract to notify the Purchasing Department of any price decrease in the market and accordingly, reduced prices will be in effect with appropriate documentation as described above.
12. The City is a tax exempt municipality, from Federal Taxes, but not from State Taxes, and an exemption certificate, will be provided upon request, for exemption from federal tax.
13. It shall be the vendor's sole responsibility to insure that the City will be delivered on clean and impurities free Unleaded and Diesel Fuels. Non-compliance with this clause, as evidence by the formation of water or other impurities in the fuel will cause for cancellation of the contract and liability of Vendor for the costs of removal, of water and other impurities.
14. Deliveries shall be made within twenty-four (24) hours after notification unless otherwise instructed, and must be made as called for by the City to the storage tanks at the location designated by the City.
15. Gasoline and Diesel must be metered from the delivery vehicle in to the storage tank. The invoice for fuel furnished shall have the meter volume as delivered stamped thereon. Fill tickets shall accompany transport deliveries. Failure to provide adequate metering devices may be sufficient cause to reject the bid.
16. The vendor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the City, the Purchasing Director, and his/her assistants from all suits and actions of every nature and discretion brought against them or any of them, for or on account of the use of patented appliances, products or processes, and he/she shall pay all royalties and charges which are legal and equitable. Evidence of such payment or satisfaction shall be submitted upon request of the Purchasing Director, as a necessary requirement in connection with the final estimate for payment in which such patented appliance, products or processes are used.
17. Respondent shall carefully examine the Bid forms, requirements/specifications, and instructions to bidders. Should the bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from Bid forms, specifications, or other documents, or should he/she be in doubt as to their meaning, he/she should at once notify the Purchasing Director (Weslaco City Hall, Purchasing Department, at 956/447-2240) and obtain clarification by addendum prior to submitting any Bids.
18. **Addenda and Interpretations:**
No Interpretations of the meaning of the specifications or other pre-bid documents will be made orally to any bidder. Every request for such interpretation should be in writing addressed to the City of Weslaco, Purchasing Department, 255 S. Kansas, Weslaco, Texas 78596, and to be given consideration must be received at least ten (10) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instruction will be in the form of written addenda for the specifications which, if issued, will be mailed/faxed or e-mailed (at the respective addresses furnished for such purposes), not later than three (3) days prior to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Failure of any bidder to receive any such addenda or interpretation shall not relieve such bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. All addenda so issued shall become part of the contract documents.
19. Location for deliveries: City Warehouse, 1912 Joe Stephens Dr., with City owned pumps. Should the City's pumps/equipment be out of service, the successful bidder shall provide fueling station (s) and honor the bid prices.
