


# City of Weslaco Polling Location for the 2016 Primary Election Electioneering Regulations and Candidate Space Assignments

**Time:** No sooner than 5:30 p.m. the regular business day immediately preceding when the polls open and any later than 72-hours after the polls close for each voting period


**Place:** Each candidate will receive no more than three tangent parking spaces. Electioneering materials must remain within the assigned parking spaces; overnight parking is permitted only within the assigned parking spaces. Candidates may place signage of any size or shape within their assigned electioneering space; neither canvassing nor electioneering is permitted any closer than the seventh parking spot west from the entrance of the building nor past the end of the same parking row.

**Manner:** It is an offense to attach or affix any political sign or electioneering material to any building or public improvement

Each political sign or electioneering material and every day such violation continues shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense (misdemeanor \$500). In addition to any criminal penalty, political signs and other electioneering materials on any public property in violation of this section may be removed and disposed of at the direction of the official in charge of the polling place.
