## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the **Gravity Sewer Line and Force Main for Lift Station No. 27** will be received at the office of the Purchasing Director, 255 S. Kansas Ave., Weslaco, Texas, 78596, until **May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2010**, at **3:00 p.m.**, for the furnishing of all necessary materials, machinery, equipment, labor, superintendence, and all other services required for the **Gravity Sewer Line and Force Main for Lift Station No. 27**, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Sigler, Winston, Greenwood & Assoc., Consulting Engineers, Weslaco, Texas. Said bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and marked on the outside, "**Gravity Sewer Line and Force Main for Lift Station No. 27, Bid No.: 2009-10-13**", and shall include acknowledgments and addenda submitted. Any bids received after the time and date specified shall not be considered.

All bids shall be accompanied by a cashier's check or certified check upon a national or state bank in the amount of five (5%) percent of the total maximum bid price, payable without recourse to Owner or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Contractor will enter into a contract.

Unless all bids are rejected, Owner agrees to give notice of award of contract to the successful contractor within sixty (60) days from the date of bid opening.

A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted.

Award will be made to the lowest responsible bidder.

Wages paid on this project must not be less than the prevailing wage rates.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on **Friday, May 14, 2010** at **10 AM**, at the Weslaco City Hall Purchasing Department, 255 S. Kansas Ave., Weslaco, Texas. All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend.
