Should you have additional household debris and yard brush, dumpsters have been placed at the following three locations:

Gibson Park - 301 S. Border Avenue  
City Hall - 255 S. Kansas Avenue  
Former City Shop – 306 S. Bridge Street

If you are displaced from your home, a Red Cross Shelter is open at First Baptist Church, 600 South Kansas Avenue. If you need financial assistance to repair your home, Affordable Homes of South Texas offers \$300.00 emergency repair grants; contact 447-8909 for an application.

Mosquito spraying and pothole patching are underway.
