History

- June 1945 First airplane (Sterman Bi-Plane) lands at Mid Valley Airport, flown by Dave Setter. Corp Dusting Service established.
- January 1946 First hangars built at Mid Valley Airport.
- January 1946 Fleetwood Airways begins operations between Mid Valley Airport and San Antonio.

History

- May 1946 Multiple runways paved at Mid Valley Airport.
- June 1946 Fleetwood Airways expands airline service to additional Texas cities from Mid Valley Airport.
- June 1946 Texas Airways begins service from Mid Valley Airport to Brownsville and Laredo.

History

- 1960's Nichols family takes over crop dusting operations at Mid Valley Airport from Dave Setter.
- 1993 Terminal Building built with funding from the Texas Department of Transportation Aviation Division.
- February 1994 First full time Airport Manager Hired by the City of Weslaco

History

- 1994 Weslaco Mid Valley Airport named Most Improved Airport in Texas by TxDOT Aviation Division.
- 1994 Self Service Fuel system installed with funds provide by EDC. Funds repaid in 1995 from fuel sales increases.
- 1995 Runway extended from 4400 feet to 5000 feet.

History

- 2010 Mid Valley Airport gains U.S Customs Designation as Landing Rights Airport. First along the Border in 40 years.
- 2011 U.S. Customs Inspection Facility completed opening the door to international flights to Mid Valley Airport.


