City Seeks Applicants to 'Weslaco 100' Committee *Volunteer Board Will Help Plan 2019 Centennial Celebration*

Weslaco—The Weslaco City Commission encourages qualified applicants to serve on the Weslaco 100 Committee, a volunteer board charged with preparing the City's centennial celebration.

"The City of Weslaco will be 100-years old in 2019," said Mayor David Suarez. "We are planning a big birthday party!"

By resolution, the Weslaco City Commission established an ad hoc citizens' committee to solicit suggestions, make recommendations, and encourage participation toward the planning and facilitating of programs and activities befitting the occasion.

"The Committee will consist of sixteen members, appointed by the City Commission to a three year term," said Suarez. "Originally, the intent was to identify entities to participate in this committee, but the Commission decided recently to include individual members. We want residents who have a passion for the past, present, and future of Weslaco to be a part of this committee to make recommendations in the planning of this special occasion."

Members named to this committee must live within the city limits. Terms are for three years without compensation.
