

Cold Weather Safety Tips:

1. Do not warm up inside using charcoal or wood. This will cause the release of carbon monoxide and is deadly. If this the only way you can keep your family and you warm, you need to open a window slightly. This is not RECOMMENDED.
2. If you have a space heater to keep warm, make sure that they are UL approved. Keep them away from furniture, blankets, clothing, curtains, or any loose material. Make sure and maintain minimum 3 foot clearance from any of the above. If you have a space heater, make sure that it has a safety feature incase of accidental tip over that will shut the heater.
3. Make sure your smoke alarms (detectors) are in working order. Test them and if they are not working change battery.
4. Do not use your stoves for heating (electric, gas, propane) as these are also dangerous and can cause a fire.
5. Before going to sleep take precautions inside your home by checking your heating appliance or appliances.
6. If someone is in need of blankets we have about 15 that we can give out. First come, first serve. We are limited.
7. If anyone wants to donate blankets or coats we will accept them and distribute.
