Low Water Pressure throughout Weslaco; Conservation Needed Now

Weslaco, TX – Currently the City of Weslaco is experiencing low water pressure throughout the distribution system.

Since water pressure in the distribution system fell below the minimum requirement, state regulations require a Boiled Water Notice be issued though there is no indication of any contamination.

We ask that all citizens:

- 1) work with us to conserve water, reducing demand on the system, while we correct this issue;
- 2) be sensitive to peak demand hours, especially 12 noon-2 p.m. at work and 5 a.m.- 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.- 8 p.m. at home; and
- 3) boil tap water before drinking until further notice.

The City will continue to address this issue; will correct it as soon as possible; and we will keep you updated. We apologize for the inconvenience caused by this service interruption but we will maintain your safety as the highest priority as we implement short and long term solutions to these water issues.
