Weslaco Firefighters Labor Union Rejects City of Weslaco's Last Collective Bargaining Offer

WESLACO TX - Following more than six months of negotiations the City of Weslaco and the Weslaco Firefighters Labor Union did not reach agreement in their discussions about a new collective bargaining agreement to cover wages, benefits and working conditions. The Firefighters Labor Union rejected the City's offer of a three-year wage package with increases that are identical to those agreed to by the Police Association in its current collective bargaining agreement.

The City is disappointed that the Labor Union rejected the City's last offer, because it was fair and balanced and met the needs of Weslaco's citizens and its Fire Department's employees. No further negotiations have been scheduled.
